- **Intern Credential:** The intern credential requires that you are enrolled in a supervision course. This requires repeating EDEL 143B. Intern credentials are valid for 2 calendar years, and restricted to a specific school agency. Concurrent enrollment in the credential program is required.
- **(b)/B** Classes designated by a B or (b) have designated sections/content for the Spanish Bilingual Authorization
- **MAT Degree:** * The ten 3-unit courses which make up the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)
- **Tuition:** Part-time = 6 units or less (generally 2 classes); Full-time = > 6 units (generally 3 classes or more) [Tuition & Fee Information](#)
- **Units:** All courses are 3 units with the exception of student teaching (Phase 1 – 4 units; Phase 2—10 units); 297 courses are 1 unit
- ***The Teacher Education Department determines the program plan and course sequence. Note that some courses must be taken concurrently with student teaching; the MAT courses (250 and 298) cannot be taken in the same semester.***
